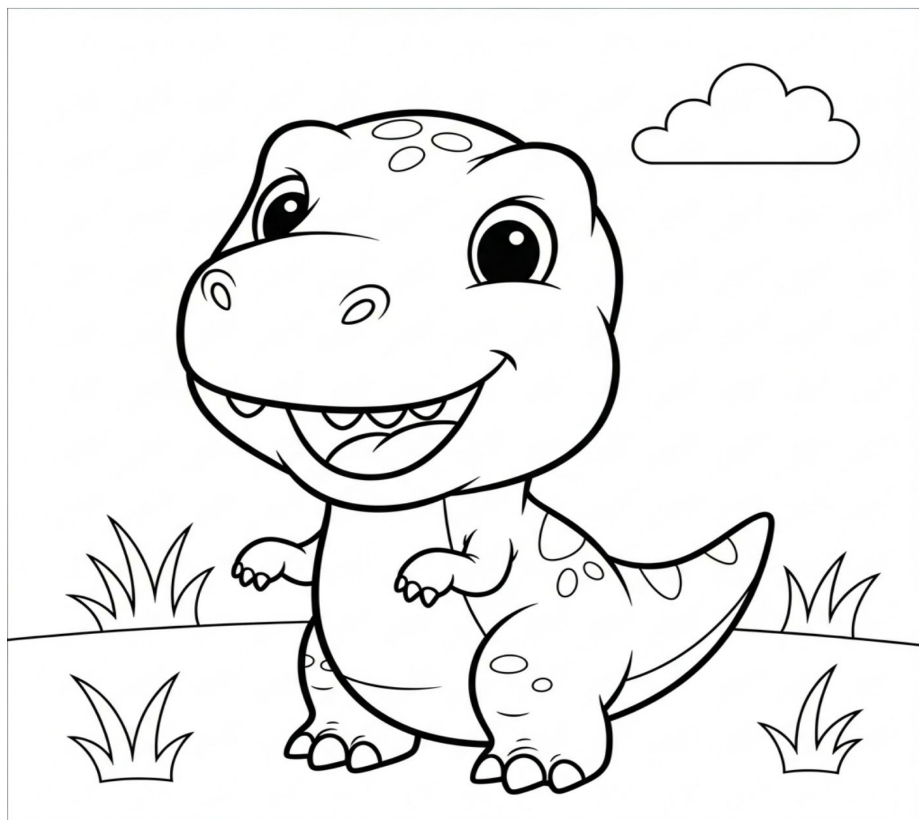

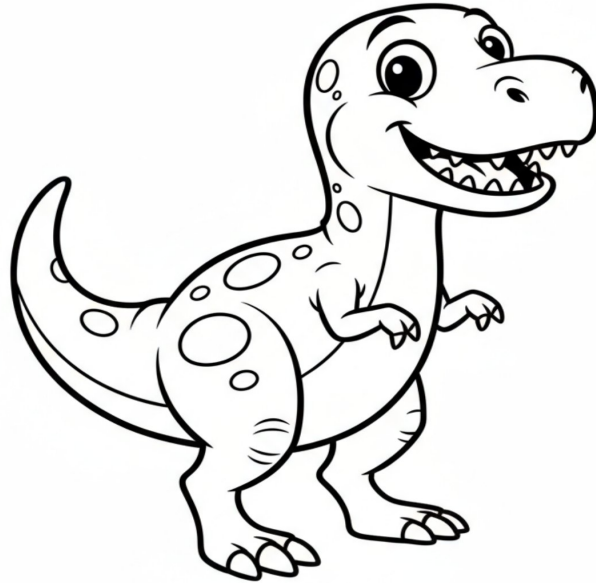

***T-Rex Playing Football – Jersey Number 10***

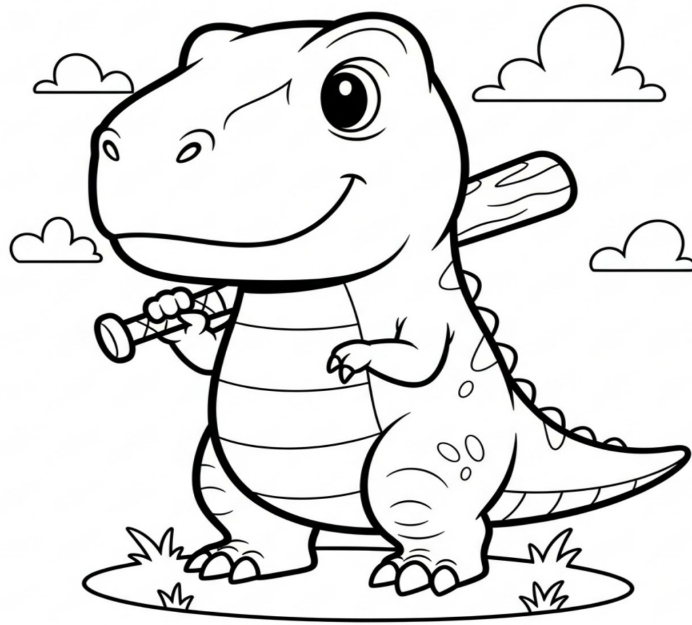

***T-Rex with a Baseball Bat – Batter Up!***

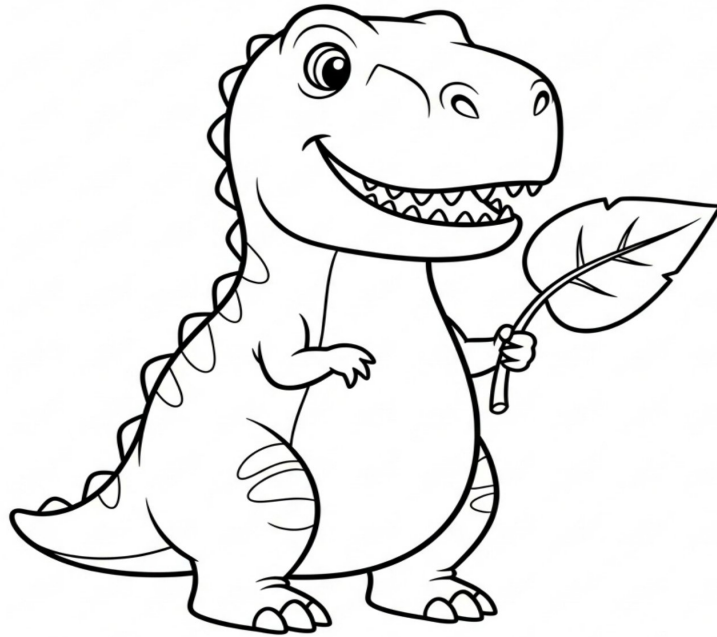

***T-Rex Holding a Leaf – Nature Explorer***

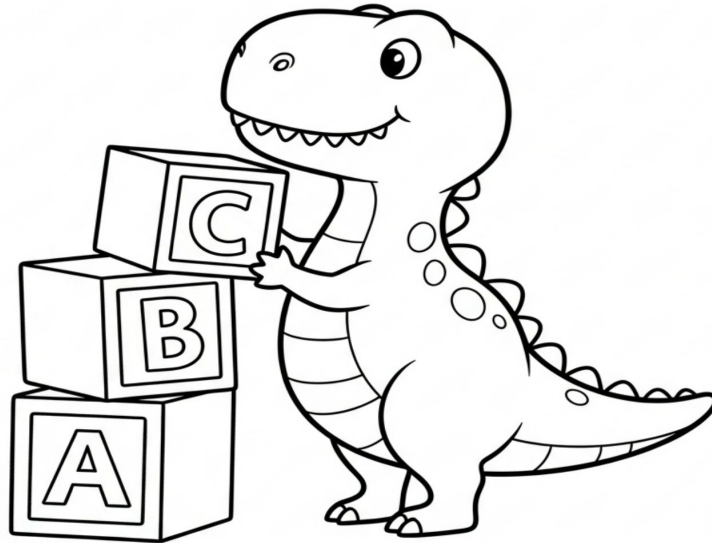

***T-Rex with ABC Blocks – Learning Has Never Been This Fun***

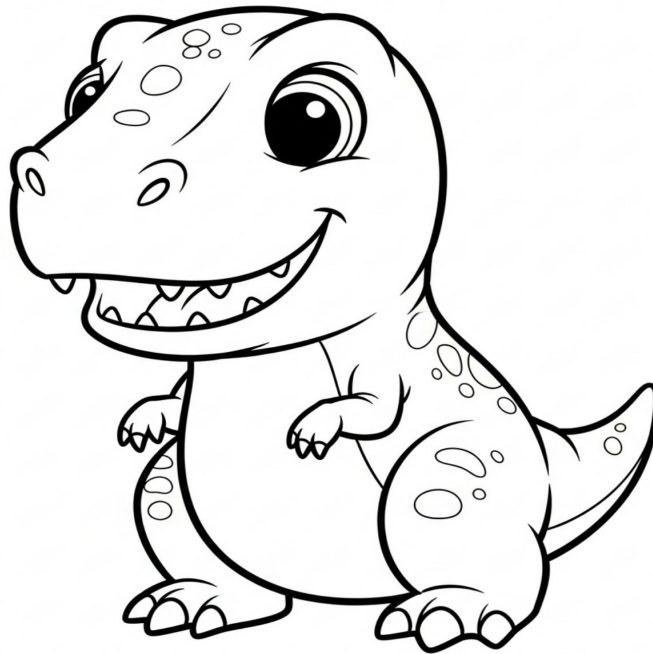

- **Print on white cardstock** — standard printer paper works fine, but 80–100 gsm cardstock holds marker and watercolor paint without bleeding or tearing.

- **Start with light colors first** — build up from pale yellows and greens before adding darker shades. This approach gives depth and makes mistakes easier to correct.
- **Use a reference image** — for the realistic T-Rex page, look up photos of actual fossils or museum reconstructions to inspire historically informed color choices.
- **Add backgrounds** — the simpler cartoon pages leave room to draw prehistoric jungles, volcanoes, or even outer space behind the dinosaur.
